There's only one thing worse than a rain out during speedway season and that's a rain out on opening night! The traditional Fireworks Opening Meeting held in the week before Guy Fawkes had to be postponed due to forecasted weather. It's not usual to cancel a race day before the rain turns up but several other factors were at play. We had club members travelling from Wellington, Hawkes Bay and Taranaki, there were other cars coming from as far away as Palmerston North and Auckland. There was also concern about the strong northerlies and how that could impact on the fireworks display' club President Russel Hayes explains. 'We made the call to postpone very early on race day morning and it turned out to be the right call' heavy rain hit the track mid afternoon dampening the embankment and leaving small lakes on the track. And unfortunately, the weather gods have not played ball again this weekend. For several days now, many of our volunteers along with the Promotions Team have been following weather reports in hope of a clear spring evening tonight. But all it's been is bad then worse then a little better. So if we do end up racing, it's either good luck or Sunday!

A stellar list of Super Saloons headed up with a big contingent from the Baypark club. Former national champion 18M Sam Waddell is here, Sam won the King Country's in the 2020/21 season and will be one to watch. Steve Cowling, a regular visitor to our track especially in his Saloon car days, is back to do one better than his 2nd placing last season behind brother Chris. Unfortunately Chris Cowling isn't defending the title he won last year but it's always great to have the Cowling family, longtime supporters of Kihikihi, here flying the flag. Also racing out of the Cowling camp is current 3NZ Craig Cardwell, a second generation driver and another fast car to watch out for. Unknown to this scriber is Australian Wayne Belk in the 32AUS/P. So good to have an international flavour competing as often as he can, I believe this will be Wayne's forth race meeting in 3 weeks. A 30 year veteran of Australian Late Model racing, Wayne will be racing his Mopar powered Super Saloon. Local lads veteran Ross Cresswell will keep the visitors honest with his super quick Hypermac Mustang and keep an eye out for Richard Dreaver hopefully still sporting the eye catching military style livery.

A 14 strong list of Midgets will compete for the King Country Champs tonight. Current 3NZ Max Guilford has experienced success racing in the US. Max will do double duties racing a Sprintcar tonight also. Former New Zealand champion Peter Hunnibell is here and stable mate Hayden Guptill has podiumed many races here at Kihikihi Domain. Local drivers Leyton Kendall and Mitch Fabish will be hard to beat on their home track and keep an eye on the 77K of Brent Curran in the fire breathing rotary weapon.

A big field of Stockcars made up of mostly local drivers, possible the largest number of Stockie drivers ever to contract to Kihikihi. A big field of Sidecars tonight too, some of the quickest teams you're likely to see at any given race meet this season. A solid list of Sprintcars and a big field of Ministocks help round out what will hopefully be another classic action packed opening night we so often see on the banks of the Kihikihi Domain Darren Powell

VICKERY'S VICTORIES

Since joining the club in 2019, the talented young driver has become Kihikihi's first New Zealand Stockcar champion (3rd place 2020) first equal New Zealand Superstock champion (3rd place 2021 with club mate 1NZ Asher Rees) and first ever World 240's champion (another 3rd place, 2022).

This off season, Mitch became New Zealand's first driver to ever podium at a major BRISCA Stockcar championship in the UK. 3rd place at the World Masters Championship in Northampton, top Kiwi drivers have visited England shores for well over 40 years such is the magnitude of Vickery's achievement.
